I joined Dundalk Photographic Society in 2013 having completed the Beginners classes in 2011. I started with a Nikon 70s and kit lens but I have since migrated to full frame using the Nikon D750 and over the years I have purchased 20mm, 50mm, 105mm prime lenses and 24-85mm, 200-500mm zoom lenses. I was promoted from the Non-Advanced section of our club league competition in 2015 and moved to the Advanced section where I've since competed.

I like to shoot every genre, landscape, portrait, still life etc in colour. I convert my colour shots to monochrome, where appropriate using Nik Silver Effects Pro, MacPhun Tonality Pro and Adobe Photoshop, In 2016 I plan to submit a panel for a Licentiateship of the Irish Photographic Federation. If successful, I would hope to try for an AIPF over the next year or two.
