On Thursday night we had the privilege of seeing the latest work of Glenn Norwood. http://www.norwoodphotography.co.uk

Glenn holds Bachelor of Arts degrees in both Art & Design and Interactive Multimedia Design and has been a qualified member of the British Institute of Professional Photographers since 1993. He was the recipient of the Kodak European Gold Award on no less than on three occasions.

Glenn grew up in Belfast and received his first camera as a young boy. He learned to process his own prints in his dark room and that experience has influenced his style ever since. Although working in the 'digital age', Glenn still tries to construct his photo shoots so that the final image is captured in the camera. As he does a lot of high-end fashion photography, there is considerable retouching in post-production but in terms of image style and creativity in lighting and texture, Glenn tries to capture all with the camera and not add it later in Photoshop. Thus, we were presented with creative images shot through Perspex, smeared with petroleum jelly and reflected from broken mirrors.

Glenn took along the prints he will be entering into this year's British Institute of Professional Photographers competition. Glenn does wide-ranging work from highend fashion to tailored product portfolios. He judges both amateur and professional competitions and we were keen to have him comment on some of our work too.
